

Oncology member story: Mary



Mary* had a CT scan before undergoing surgery to remove her thyroid, and the results revealed a lesion on her right lung that turned out to be a cancerous tumour.

Further testing, including a biopsy, confirmed the presence of adenocarcinoma, a type of cancer that starts in the mucous glands inside organs like the lungs.

Mary underwent a resection of her right lung to remove the

tumour. The pathology results were consistent with a diagnosis of stage 1 lung cancer, and there was no evidence that the cancer had spread to the lymph nodes.

Mary's surgeon recommended that she undergo surveillance scans every six months and did not feel she required any further treatment.

Seeking reassurance on this

recommendation, as well as a second medical opinion about the further evaluation and management of her condition, Mary reached out to Best Doctors, which she had access to through her insurer.

Best Doctors gathered Mary's information and her case was reviewed by a Best Doctors oncologist, who agreed with the diagnosis of stage 1 lung cancer. The Best Doctors expert explained that the fact the cancer had not spread to the lymph nodes reaffirmed there was a low risk of recurrence. Best Doctors confirmed these findings by reviewing Mary's pathology samples.

The Best Doctors expert also agreed with the surgeon's recommendation of surveillance scans to monitor for any signs of recurrence, and agreed that no additional therapy was needed. He explained that there is no good evidence that chemotherapy for stage 1 lung cancer helps reduce the risk of recurrence and that there is a 90 percent chance there will be no recurrence of the cancer, even by doing

nothing further.

The Best Doctors expert recommended follow-up CT scans of the chest and abdomen every three months for the next two years, scaled back to every six months for the following two years, and then further scaled back to yearly CT scans thereafter.
